Rhynaclach Land Management Plan 2016-2026 Summary of Proposals

Rhynaclach Land Management Plan area lies close to the village of Port of Menteith, occupying a position on the southern slopes of the Menteith Hills overlooking the River Forth. This a new acquisition and the plan describes planting proposals which have been consulted on and discussed with local communities and other stakeholders. About 72ha of the 167.5ha property are being retained as a starter farm and the whole will demonstrate best practice in integrated land use. The key objective for the woodlands is to plant a mix of broadleaved species for production and habitat creation.
