

The overall landscape concept is to create a woodland which reflects smooth shapes, the transition in scale and an appropriate level of diversity reflecting topography and is accessible so that it can be managed in a sustainable way. The planting plan also makes the most of species diversity reflecting the site potential

ROADLINE

Being located along the lower slopes of the hill, so that it is associated with the infrastructure along the valley floor but still provides the necessary access required for woodland management


